1. Pre-reading speaking exercise: What's the story?

Have a look at the word cloud below. These are all words from the article on page 1 of our current January issue.

Working in groups of three, gather ideas on what the article could be about. Prepare a short summary of your ideas (about one to two minutes) and share it with the class.



2. Post-reading speaking exercise: Why do people migrate?

There are many reasons why people leave their home country and emigrate to a different country.

What are some reasons you can think of? You have five to ten minutes to write down your responses on a piece of paper. You don't need to write full sentences; keywords will do. You can also refer back to the article to find reasons that are given by migrants themselves (paragraphs 11, 13, and 14).

Form groups of three and swap your pieces of paper. Take some time to read through the ideas of your fellow student. Then use your own words and full sentences to tell the group what the other student's responses were.
